JOB DESCRIPTION:

- * Serve as a resource person for District and Unit Club Presidents and their Community Relations Chairmen;
- * Work with Unit Clubs to promote "Caring for America" projects;
- * Educate the membership on non-political ways they can serve their communities;
- * Encourage Republican women to take leadership roles in civic activities;
- * Devise Community Relations programs on the state level and submit to the MoFRW President; e.g. a project in conjunction with the annual convention;
- * Promote the idea of volunteerism in the communities, utilizing resources available through "Caring for America";
- * Recommend to the MoFRW ways in which it can publicly recognize those Republican women who make a special effort to promote and practice volunteerism in their communities;
- * Be available as a speaker for District and Unit Clubs, as requested;
- * Submit timely information for MoFRW President for distribution to unit clubs;
- * Submit a written report of the committee's activities for each meeting of the Board of Directors;
- * Compile a file or notebook of pertinent information for reference and pass it on to your successor.
