

# **The Purpose and Benefits of Forming a Federated Republican Women's Club.**

1. To increase and encourage Republican women's participation in the government process, locally, statewide and nationally.
2. To elect Republicans to office at all levels of government and to promote public awareness of the issues which shape our nation.
3. To encourage and promote political education in women of all ages.
4. To gain strength in numbers and organization in order to promote the Republican Party.
5. To be informed.
6. To recruit and train candidates, both women and men, in order to elect Republican candidates at all levels of government.
7. To educate and get voters to the polls.
8. Membership in a Republican Women's club consists of four levels – the local club, the Missouri Federation of Republican Women, the Congressional District in which the club is chartered, and the National Federation of Republican Women.
9. Every member has individual rights as prescribed in their bylaws in their respective club. All members have voting rights at the Congressional District meetings. Each club sends delegates and alternates for representation to the Missouri Federation of Republican Women's Annual Convention. Each club may send a delegate and alternate to the National Federation of Republican Women's Biannual Convention.
